 List of any serious medical or mental health issue that a parent or child sufferes from
 Your current expected monthly budget (while living apart) if support alimony will be an issue. Use monthly estimated averages for each category, for example, if auto insurance costs \$1,200 per year then the monthly budgeted amount would be \$100.
